#### Birth to 3

Birth to 3 Program is an early intervention program for children with developmental delays and disabilities ages birth to 3 and their families. Provides in-home support to families through evidence based practices.

#### Child Protection

For emergency and afterhours please call 911. Provides case management services to children and their families to maintain safety, permanency, and well-being. A place to report child abuse or neglect.

#### Children's Long Term Support Services

Provides community-based services to maintain children in their homes that have developmental, physical, or mental health disabilities. Services are provided within the home and community to meet the health and safety needs of children.

#### Family Centered Treatment

In home, community, and collaborative based program that provides more intensive treatment, meeting with therapist several times a week for multiple hour sessions to work towards family goals.
