## Portable Recycling Bins for Special Events

- For best results... put a recycling bin next to each trash bin. Make the choice easy!
- (40) portable recycling bins are available for public event use
- Bins are free to use (\$50/bin deposit is refundable when bins are returned in good condition)
- Each bin comes with two clear bags to gather the recycling
- Additional bags can be purchased \$5 for 10 bags
- Bins are picked-up and dropped-off in Baldwin at the AG Center
- Call the Recycling Specialist to reserve the portable recycling bins for your next event!



Collected recycling should then be loosely disposed in your appropriate dumpster. Plastic bags go in the trash.

## Why Recycle at Special Events?



### It's the law!

Events need to provide recycling for:

- Aluminum and steel cans
- Plastic food and beverage containers #1 and #2
- Glass bottles and jars
- **Empty all contents first**
